The York County Council met on the above date for a York County Council Workshop at 6:00pm located at 1070 Heckle Boulevard, Large Conference Room, Rock Hill, South Carolina. The following Council members were present: Council member Tommy Adkins, Council member Tom Audette, Council member Allison Love, Chairwoman Christi Cox, Council member Watts Huckabee, and Council member Debi Cloninger. Also present were County Manager, David Hudspeth, Assistant County Manager, Mike Moore, Assistant County Manager, Kevin Madden, County Attorney, Michael Kendree, and Clerk to Council, Karen Brogdon.

Chairwoman Christi Cox called the meeting to order.

Assistant County Manager, Mike Moore provided an update on the animal control facility. Mr. Moore reported that the focus is now to renovate and expand the current facility, as there is a potential for cost savings. Mr. Moore stated that the scope will need to be revised and a new RFQ will come to Council in possibly April or May. Mr. Moore also stated that the scope might include consideration for large animals. Staff will work diligently to attempt to keep the renovation/expansion costs within the \$16M budget. Staff will also work with the consultant to determine the best course of action for the current animals at the shelter.

Executive Session

Motion was made by Council member Tom Audette and seconded by Council member Allison Love to go into Executive Session for Receipt of Legal Advice: Fire AUP and Matters Related to Administration, Receipt of Legal Advice/Contractual Matter: Water and Sewer Services and Receipt of Legal Advice: Litigation Update. Motion was made by Council member Tom Audette and seconded by Council member Debi Cloninger to remove the July 1 fire deadlines for all matters related to administration with exception of accounts payable and will recall the items from Justice & Public Safety Committee to Council to evaluate ordinances and policies.
