

Minutes
Finance & Operations Meeting
Monday, February 1, 2021
5:30pm

The York County Finance & Operations Committee met on the above date for a Finance & Operations Committee Meeting at 5:30pm in the Government Center, 6 South Congress Street, York, SC. The following Council members were present: Council member Robert Winkler, Council member Allison Love and Council member Joel Hamilton. Also present were County Manager, David Hudspeth, Assistant County Manager, Kevin Madden, County Attorney, Michael Kendree and Clerk to Council, Karen Brogdon.

Summary and Actions:

1. Motion was made by Council member Allison Love and seconded by Council member Joel Hamilton to recommend for consideration by Council the appointments of John Segura for a three year term, pending eligibility requirements being resolved, Ricky Brake for a two year term and Tim Schilling and Anne Violanti for a one year term to the Bethel-Lake Wylie Land Acquisition and Preservation Parks District Board. Motion Carried.

Motion was made by Council member Allison Love and seconded by Council member Joel Hamilton to recommend for consideration by Council the appointment of Perry Johnston, pending eligibility requirements being resolved, to the Lake Wylie Parks and Recreation District (Field Day Park). Motion Carried.
3. Motion was made by Council member Allison Love and seconded by Council member Joel Hamilton to recommend for consideration by Council the appointment of Tom Smith to the Lake Wylie Parks and Recreation District (Field Day Park). Motion Carried.
4. Motion was made by Council member Allison Love and seconded by Council member Joel Hamilton to recommend for consideration by Council the reappointment of Russ Partin to the Lake Wylie Parks and Recreation District (Field Day Park). Motion Carried.

Aaron Seigler, Auditor/Internal Auditor provided a monthly financial update and explained that December tax revenues are continuing to come in. It was also explained that the Sheriff's Department continues to have significant vacancies. As of December 2020, it was 9.3%. The General Fund departments as of December 2020 had a 4.9% vacancy rate.
