

Minutes
Finance & Operations Meeting
Monday, July 19, 2021
5:30pm

The York County Finance & Operations Committee met on the above date for a Finance & Operations Committee Meeting at 5:30pm in the Government Center, 6 South Congress Street, York, SC. The following Council members were present: Council member Robert Winkler, Council member Allison Love and Council member Joel Hamilton (arrived late). Also present were County Manager, David Hudspeth, Assistant County Manager, Mike Moore, County Attorney, Michael Kendree, and Clerk to Council, Karen Brogdon.

Summary and Actions:

1. Motion was made by Council member Allison Love and seconded by Council member Robert Winkler to recommend for consideration by Council the appointment of Angie Clinton to the Bethel-Lake Wylie Land Acquisition and Preservation Parks District Board. Motion Carried.
2. Motion was made by Council member Allison Love and seconded by Council member Robert Winkler to recommend for consideration by Council the reappointment of Penny Sheppard to the York County Culture and Heritage Commission (District 1). Motion Carried.
3. Motion was made by Council member Allison Love and seconded by Council member Robert Winkler to rescind the prior vote to move Stephen Ballenger from the District 6 seat on Keep York County Beautiful to an At Large seat and to authorize the movement of John Edwards from the District 3 seat to an At Large seat on Keep York County Beautiful. Motion Carried.
4. Motion was made by Council member Allison Love and seconded by Council member Joel Hamilton to approve the request for allocation of funds from the District 3 Discretionary Spending Program to Sharon Fire Department Access Driveway. Motion Carried.

A discussion was held regarding an ordinance amendment for York County Convention and Visitor's Bureau. County Manager, David Hudspeth offered a couple of suggestions to the Committee. 1. The County Council appoint 7 members and other municipalities appoint the remaining 8 seats; or 2. The CVB be absorbed into the City of Rock Hill as a department with continued funding by the County and Municipalities. There was a request from Management for additional time to research the options and make a recommendation to the Committee in August.

There being no additional matters to discuss a motion was made by Council member Joel Hamilton and seconded by Council member Allison Love to adjourn the meeting. Motion Carried.
