Aaron Seigler, Auditor presented the finance update for November 2024. Mr. Seigler reported that as of November 2024 the Sheriff’s Office continues to have significant vacancies at 8.2% and the general fund departments in November 2024 was 6.3%. This is the primary reason for the projected surplus in FY25.
