Reports

1. Executive Director

Alan Helms shared:

- Staff are organizing the multitude of 2024 materials and equipment, and continuing to prepare for upcoming municipal elections
- In June, Helms will receive his Certified Elections Registration Administrator Certification
- In July, staff and York County delegation members will discuss best practices for working together
- SCARE continues to focus on the benefits of Early Voting and election efficiencies
- New offices will be constructed for the Communications Manager and the Voter Services Manager

Old Business

1. Early Voting and Election Day Polling Locations Updates

Per Helms, for Early Voting two of four are confirmed. For Election Day, 19 of 56 polling places are confirmed.

2. Municipal Election Workshop

Helms shared that staff have workshops scheduled for city/town administrators of all nine municipalities. Topics include candidate filing, costs and invoicing, and timelines.

New Business

1. Announcement of New Board Member

Helms announced that Patty Teter will become a new board member in August 2025.

2. Candidate Filing for 2025 Municipal Election Day

Helms reminded the board that candidate filing is for 30 days; opening on Wednesday, Aug. 6 and closing on Friday, Sept. 5. Filing will take place during office hours.

3. Protest Hearing Workshop

Helms recommended staff and the board produce a mock protest hearing to learn the process and improve preparedness.

Other Business

J. Hagner and S. Culp inquired about the status of the 2025-2026 budget. Helms explained that the County Council meeting was currently in session and the third reading of the budget was on their agenda.
