3. TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE APPROVAL OF \$1,325,200.00 TRANSFER FROM EXIT 90 TO EXIT 82.

Executive Summary: County Council, County Administration and the County Engineering Department have an agreement with the State Infrastructure Bank to provide a local match on the traffic engineering improvements on Exit 82. Funds were previously allocated toward Exit 90 and a new agreement has been established allowing the funds to be transferred to and utilized on Exit 82. The recommended transfer of \$1,325,200.00 from Exit 90 to Exit 82 are in compliance with the new SIB agreement and will be beneficial to the improvements on Exit 82. The funds were previously allocated from our C-Fund Program, so this will not involve any additional funds from our accounts, only an administrative transfer, with Committee approval.
